ASSESSOR NOTES

Assessor hours are the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of the month from 3:30pm-5:30pm. Please call for an appointment (315)-543-2111 ext. 14, as we are routinely out in the field. Those who currently receive the basic star "exemption" off the school tax bill and are turning 65 in 2024, should contact the Assessor to see if they qualify for the enhanced star exemption. Those who get the star "credit" must register with the state by going online to www.tax.ny.gov/star or call (518)-457-2036 M-F 8:30 am - 4:30 pm. Those who get the credit receive a check in September rather than getting the savings off the school tax bill. You can NOT receive both. Those who get the exemption off the school tax bill are grandfathered in.
